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



PREPARING THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR HOME FOR SPRINGTIME

Exterior Home Spring Check Lists:

Roof & Gutters Checklist

Clean Gutters & Downspouts

• Clear any debris out of the gutters & make sure the downspouts are directed away from your house

Check Gutters for Damage

· Check for holes or cracks

Check for Roof Damage

 Check for any damaged/missing shingles. You may also want to inspect your attic for any signs of leaks or moisture

Air Conditioning System Checklist

Inspect The Unit's Panels

 Inspect the panels that enclose and protect the electrical system making sure they're still secured properly and haven't sustained damage

Clear Away Debris

 Remove leaves, twigs, and other vegetation that may be on or around the A/C unit. You may also want to check the inside of the unit for any debris

Change The Air Filter

 It's always a good idea to put in a new air filter before turning your A/C on for the season and maintain it by changing it out regularly

Home Exterior Maintenance Checklist

Siding

 Take a walk around your home and look for any siding damages. Be sure to repair/replace any extremely weathered or cracked pieces. For wood siding, peeling or loose paint should be scraped, sanded and repainted

Windows

 Check for peeling or cracked caulk around the seals. Repair or replace any screens with holes to prevent bugs

Deck

 Consider resealing your deck if it's showing a lot of age. HomeAdviser recommends retreating wood decks every 6 years.

Foundation

• If you have a brick home, inspect the mortar and see if any crack need to be repaired.

Landscaping

• Trim back shrubs and trees away from your home after winter ends and throughout spring. This will help keep the siding on your home from getting scratched or damaged.

Interior Home Spring Check Lists: General Cleaning (ALWAYS DUST FIRST)

- Dust Light Fixtures
- Dust Light Switches / Electrical Outlets
- Dust/ Clean Baseboards
- Replace Light Bulbs
- Replace Batteries in Alarms / Detectors
- Clean Window Sills, Blinds, & Curtains
- Sweep, Mop, & Vaccum all floors

Kitchen + Dining Cleaning

- Clean Out Refrigerator / Pantry
 - Throw away all perishable / non-perishable foods & spices that have expired or will expire soon
- Deep Clean Appliances
- Sweep Underneath Appliances

Living Area Cleaning

- Dust Flat Surfaces
- Dust / Wipe Down Decor
- Wash Throw Blankets & Pillows
- Clean Beneath Couch Cushions
- Move Furniture & Clean Underneath

Bedroom Cleaning

- Wash Bedding
- Flip/ Rotate Mattress
- Change Out Winter Clothes for Spring/Summer Clothes
- Organize Clothing & Storage

Bathroom Cleaning

- Throw Away Empty Bottles / Canisters
- Clean Out & Organize Drawers / Cabinets
- Clean Mirror
- Clean Sink & Cabinet
- Clean Toilet Inside and Out
- Clean Tub, Shower Walls, Faucet, & Shower Head
- Deep Clean Tile Grout & Reseal If Needed
- Wash Bath Mats and Curtains
- Clean Shower Liner
